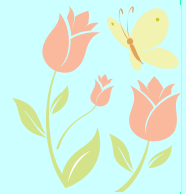

We have an exciting year for your child this year! Here are a few points to remember in order to make this the very best experience for you and your child...

CHOIR TIME is from 6:00—7:00 p.m. each Wednesday. Please do not pick up your child early unless there is an emergency. We need every minute to teach them! We will be accepting children **NO EARLIER THAN 5:55!** Please consider this! Our leadership is coming from work too, and need this time to prepare. Also, prior to choir, please feed them, and take your child to the POTTY before they come to choir. All children entering our choir program **need** to be potty-trained.

WEEKLY REGISTRATION: Child safety is a top priority at Joyland, so please register your child each week at the Joyland station before bringing them to choir. No child will be accepted without their nametag sticker, nor will a child be released without accompanying claim sticker

LATE ROOM: If your child is staying for only children's choir, and they are not picked up by 7:00, they will be taken to the room for TeamKid.
