TEXAS BAPTIST MEN and HAITI RELIEF

Several members of THBC were ENGAGED two weeks ago helping Texas Baptist Men [TBM] prepare water filter systems for shipment to Haiti. Under the direction of Bob Young, the Water Ministry VP for TBM, 5,000 water purification systems were prepared for shipment. Each system, made with a bucket and a filter pack, costs about \$40 and provides pure water to a family for up to 6 months. This is the second shipment of 5,000 bucket systems shipped to Haiti by TBM. The bucket systems are distributed for free to Haitian families thru Baptist church leaders in Haiti.
