Have you ever felt peer pressure to live your Christian life in a certain manner? This tendency to add works to salvation has persistently been a problem throughout Christendom. For some, the concept of being “worthy” is found by following a set of staid rules and regulations on how to live. But the GOOD NEWS OF THE GOSPEL is not that we are required to continue conforming to the restrictions of the law—the good news is that we are free in Christ!

Legalism---the doctrine of salvation by works---robs the Christian of the abundant life that Christ died to provide. Branding Christianity as a set of rules to be followed is so devastating and detrimental to the faith that it has to be aggressively addressed whenever it rears its head. THE BOOK OF GALATIANS answered this need with one of the clearest presentations and defenses of the Gospel of grace in all of Scripture.

We will study Galatians on a verse-verse journey. Paul’s argument for justification by faith alone and the supremacy of Christ over the law is as relevant and real today as it was two thousand years ago. REMEMBER the gift of salvation is God’s marvelous demonstration of grace that is borne wholly through faith in Jesus Christ.

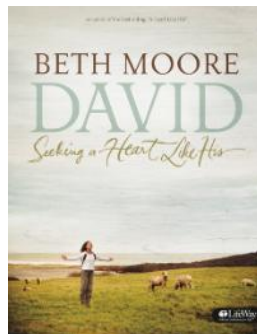

The Book of Acts

As we continue our study of Acts in chapter 8, we'll see the gospel spreading outside of Jerusalem because of the persecution of the believers. We'll see where the Holy Spirit leads Phillip and walk with Saul as Jesus convinces Saul that Jesus is the Messiah. God continues to use Peter and convicts him through a vision that the gospel is for Gentiles, too. The church in Antioch of Syria shared the good news with the Greeks and attracted the attention of the church in Jerusalem. The Jerusalem church sent Barnabas to verify the happenings and later to set standards for the Gentile believers. Barnabas goes for Saul to assist the church in Antioch. Meanwhile Peter is arrested and put in jail, but God does not allow King Herod to take Peter's life. It is from Antioch that Barnabas and Paul are sent out on their first missionary journey. We'll travel with them on this journey and later with Paul and Silas as they spread the Gospel. We'll also travel with Paul on his journey to Rome.

As we do a verse-by-verse study of Acts together we'll see that Jesus' mission on earth is to be carried on by his followers including present day believers who are empowered by the Holy Spirit. There will be opportunity for questions, clarification and referencing to other Biblical passages. Personal study and the application of its teachings to our daily lives will be encouraged along with personal prayer requests.
