**Chuck Rice's** (4/25) mother-in-law passed away. They are in Oklahoma taking care of details.

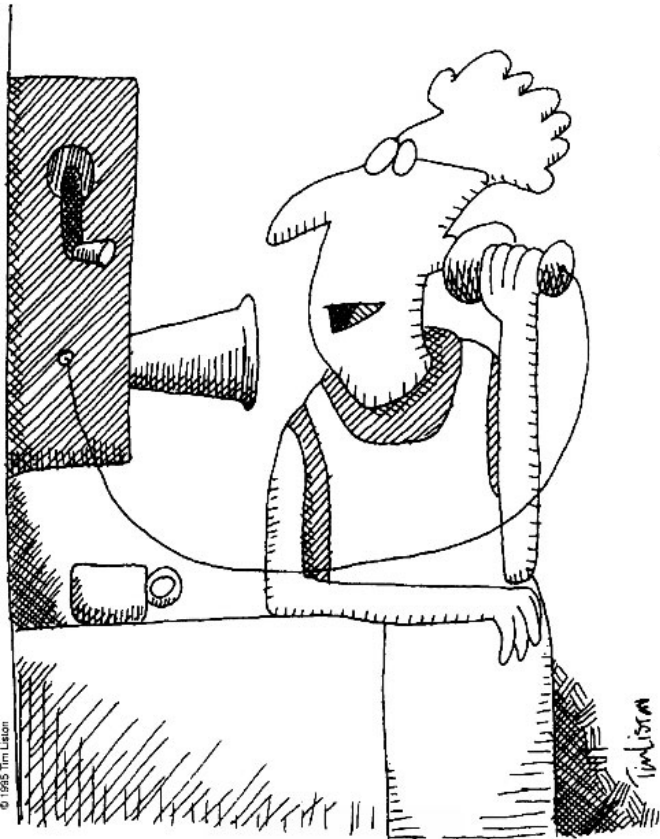
**Richard Ackles** (4/17) mom, Dorothy, has shingles and is having a difficult time getting through all the pain, medication and healing.
